



Statement of Evidence:

NORTH QUARTER CORNER  
SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 101 NORTH, RANGE 40 WEST  
5th PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, MINNESOTA

- 14 Oct. 1868 -George G. Howe, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, "West on random between Sec.s 18 & 19" @ 40.00 chs. "Set temporary 1/4 post". "S 89-59 E between Sec. 18 & 19" @ 40.27 chs. "Set post in mound with pits for 1/4 sec. corner", no ties.
- 2 Dec. 2005 -Bolton & Menk, Inc. calculated the position of the lost corner by proportioning between the Northeast and Northwest corners of Section 19. This position is 4.4 feet West of the southerly extension of an existing fence line located near the center of Section 18 and running South approximately 1/4 mile, and in the centerline of a east – west gravel road.
- Bolton & Menk, Inc. excavated an area 8 feet east – west, 4 feet north – south and 4 feet deep. Bolton & Menk, Inc. searched with a probe and metal locator at the bottom of the excavated area and found nothing. The excavation covered the area between the above referenced lost position and the intersection of the southerly extension of said existing fence and the centerline of the gravel road.
- 26 April 2006 -Bolton & Menk, Inc. set a 2" X 2" X 30" Telspar Monument with MnDot Cap at the above referenced lost position.

The evidence is not conclusive as to the true corner location, however the occupational and collateral evidence suggest that this is a reasonable location as to the corner.
