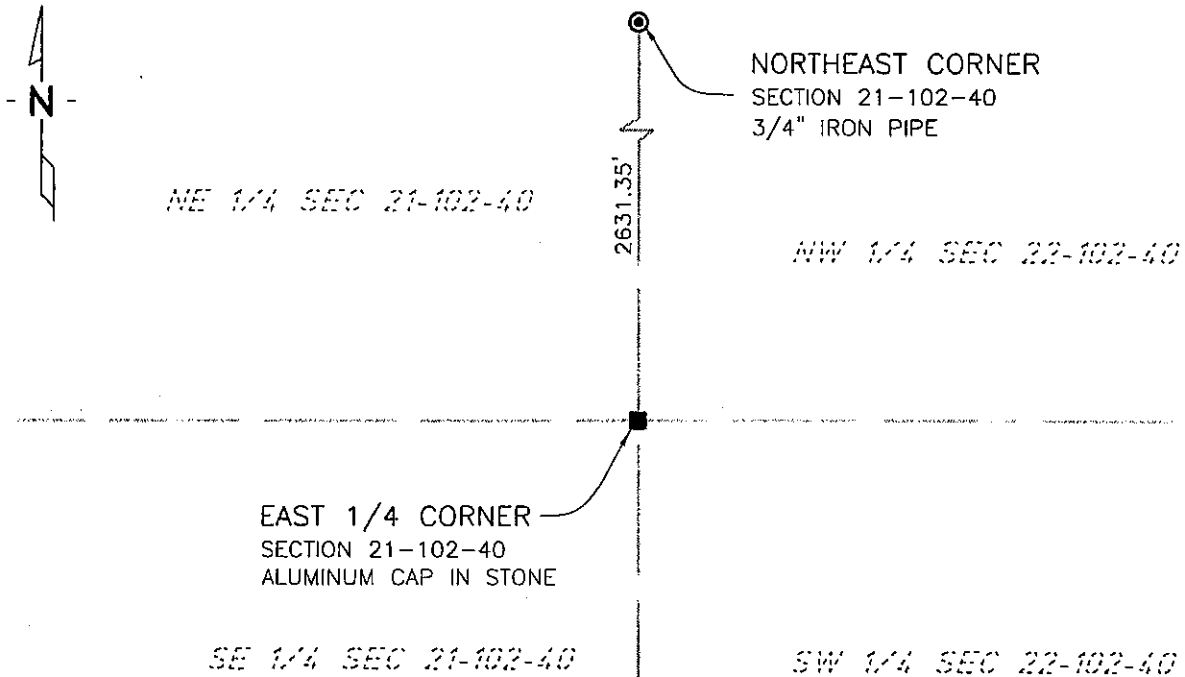

Original Notes

- 1892 Nobles County Highway Department records show a stone monument being set.
- 1994 Nobles County Highway Department records show Madsen Land Surveying Inc., Fairmont, found a large stone with an "X" on the southwest side of corner fence post, protruding 12". The ties are as follows  
Bottle Cap in FE Post – South 9.53'  
CL of CSAH #10 – East 116.8'  
Bottle Cap in Cor FE Post – East 0.90'  
SPK in Tree – Northeast 8.75'
- 1998 Field notes received by Madsen Land Surveying Inc., Fairmont, shows a found "X" in stone. Drilled hole in "X" and placed a 5/8"x10" iron rod with aluminum cap. The ties are as follows:  
Bottle Cap in Wood Post – Northeast 0.87'  
Bottle Cap in Wood Post – South 9.56'  
CL road N&S – East 111.0'
- 2003 On July 16, Bolton & Menk, Inc., Mankato, found an aluminum cap in a stone.
