East Quarter Corner of Section 4, Township 103 North, Range 42 West, 5th Principal Meridian, Nobles County, Minnesota.

1869-Deputy Surveyor set a post in mound with pits.

1897- Nobles County Highway Department "Corner Ties Book" calls for a stone set to mark the corner location.

1901- Nobles County Highway Department "Corner Ties Book" calls for a stone to mark the corner location.

1938- Nobles County Highway Department "Corner Ties Book" calls for a stone to mark the corner location.

1955- Nobles County Highway Department "Corner Ties Book" calls for an iron pin to mark the corner location.

1994- Nobles County Highway Department "Corner Ties Book" calls that the monument was raised (no description) and a 2 1/2" PK was placed to mark the corner location after an overlay and ties set.

2017- Westwood Professional Services recovered 5/8" rebar near centerline and a field line to the west. The monument agrees closely with the highway plans. Accepting as the best available evidence of the corner. Ties were found or set as shown on the front of this certificate.
