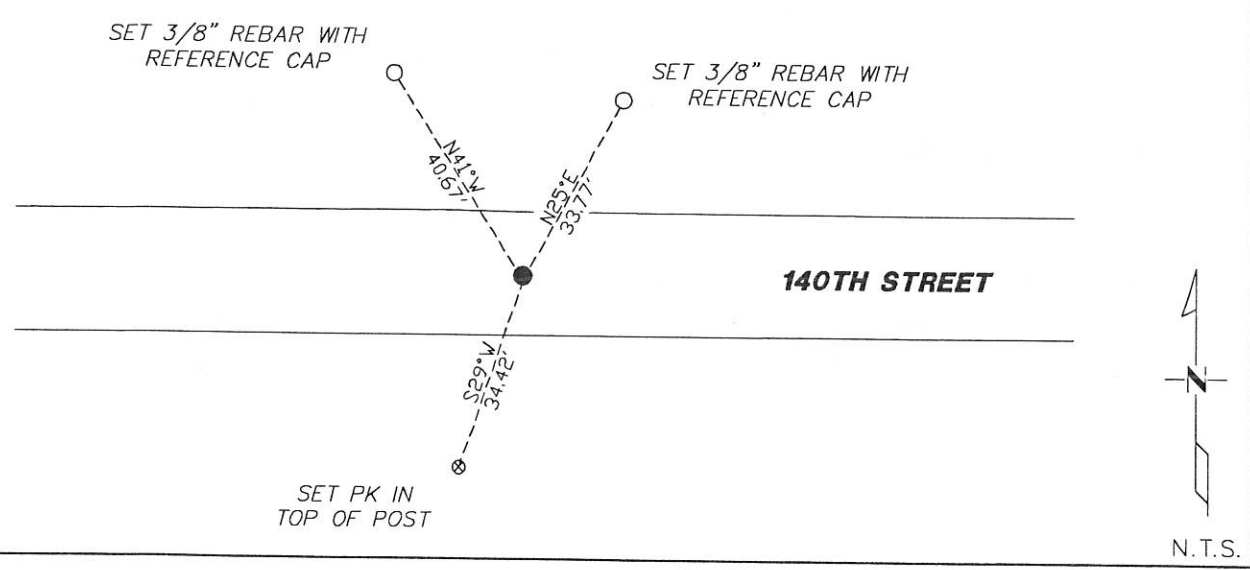

Statement of Evidence:

R-15

North Quarter Corner of Section 27, Township 104 North, Range 41 West, 5th Principal Meridian, Nobles County, Minnesota.

1868-Deputy Surveyor Richard N. L. Jeorlt, set a post in mound with pits for the section corner.

1936-Nobles County Highway Department "Corner Ties Book" calls for a stake at the corner location.

2017-On November 9th, Westwood Professional Services searched at E/W centerline and online with berm running south, found nothing. Set a 5/8" rebar capped 49563 equidistant between the NE and NW corners of Section 27 T.104 R.41 and slid to centerline. Position lands +/-5 ft. east of northerly berm extension. Ties were found or set as shown on the front of this certificate.

Analysis of the recovered data, field evidence and survey measurements, indicates that the monument found is the correct perpetuation of this corner. For additional information concerning this corner please contact Westwood Professional Services.
