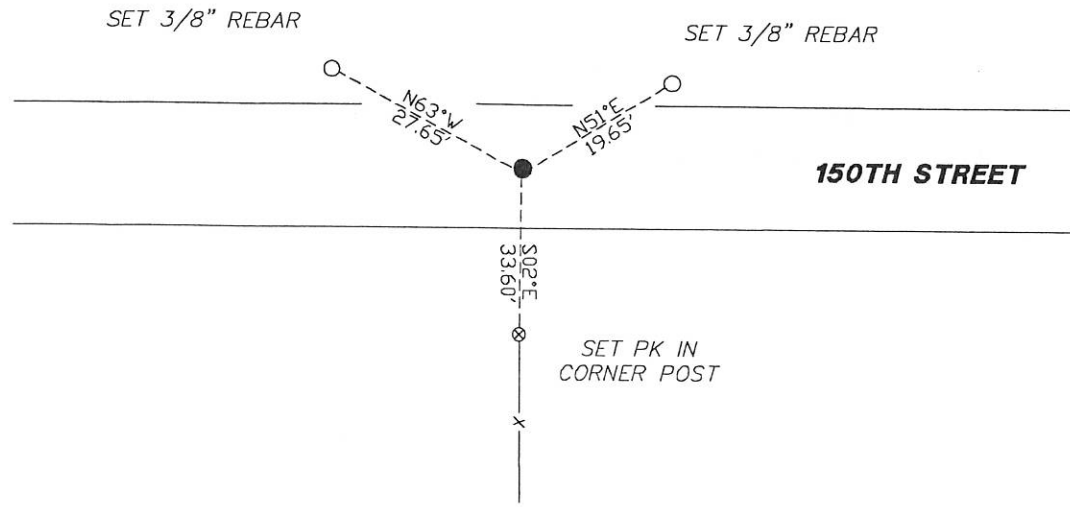

North Quarter Corner of Section 35, Township 104 North, Range 41 West, 5th Principal Meridian, Nobles County, Minnesota.

1868-Deputy Surveyor Richard N. L. Jeorlt, set a post in mound with pits for the section corner.

2017-On November 8th, Westwood Professional Services found a 3/8" rebar on E/W centerline and +/-2 ft. W. of a fence line running south. Monument lands +/-10 ft. west of single proportion location. Accepting the found rebar as the best available evidence of the corner position. Set 3 ties.
