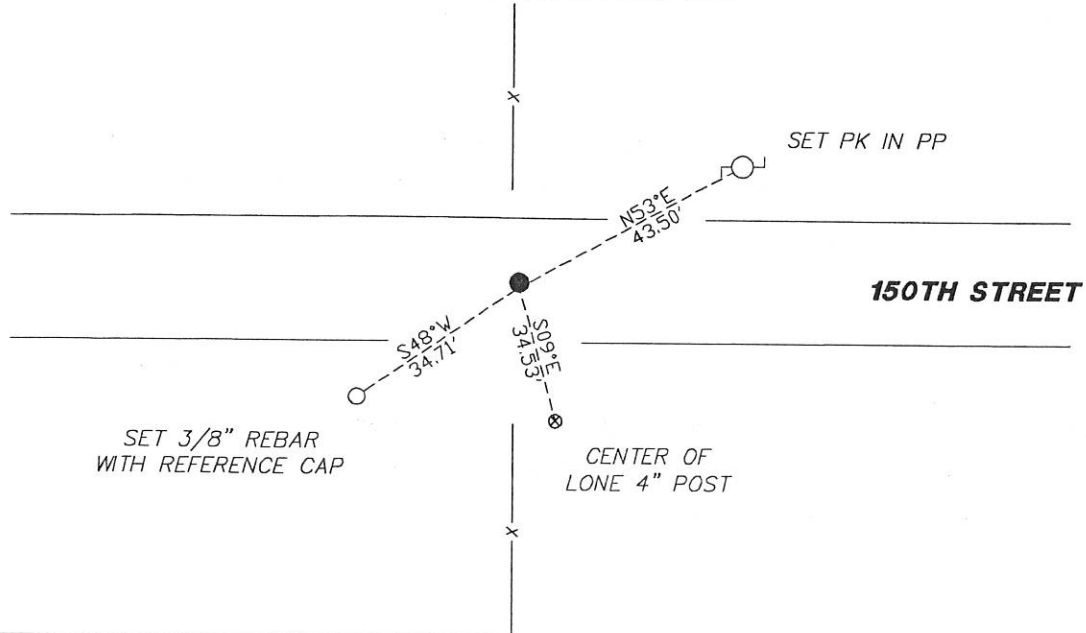

North Quarter Corner of Section 32, Township 104 North, Range 41 West, 5th Principal Meridian, Nobles County, Minnesota.

1868-Deputy Surveyor Richard N. L. Jeorlt, set a post in mound with pits for the section corner.

1900-Surveyor's Record Book A-2, page 382, prepared by County Surveyor M.S. Smith shows a stone at the corner location. Distance to the SW corner of Sec. 28 T.104 R.41 is shown to be 2650.1 ft.

2017-On November 9th, Westwood Professional Services found nothing. Set a 5/8" rebar capped 49563 on E/W centerline and on line with fence lines running north and south. E/W centerline and fence line extension intersection fits the 1900 survey distances. Set 3 ties.

Analysis of the recovered data, field evidence and survey measurements, indicates that the monument found is the correct perpetuation of this corner. For additional information concerning this corner please contact Westwood Professional Services.
