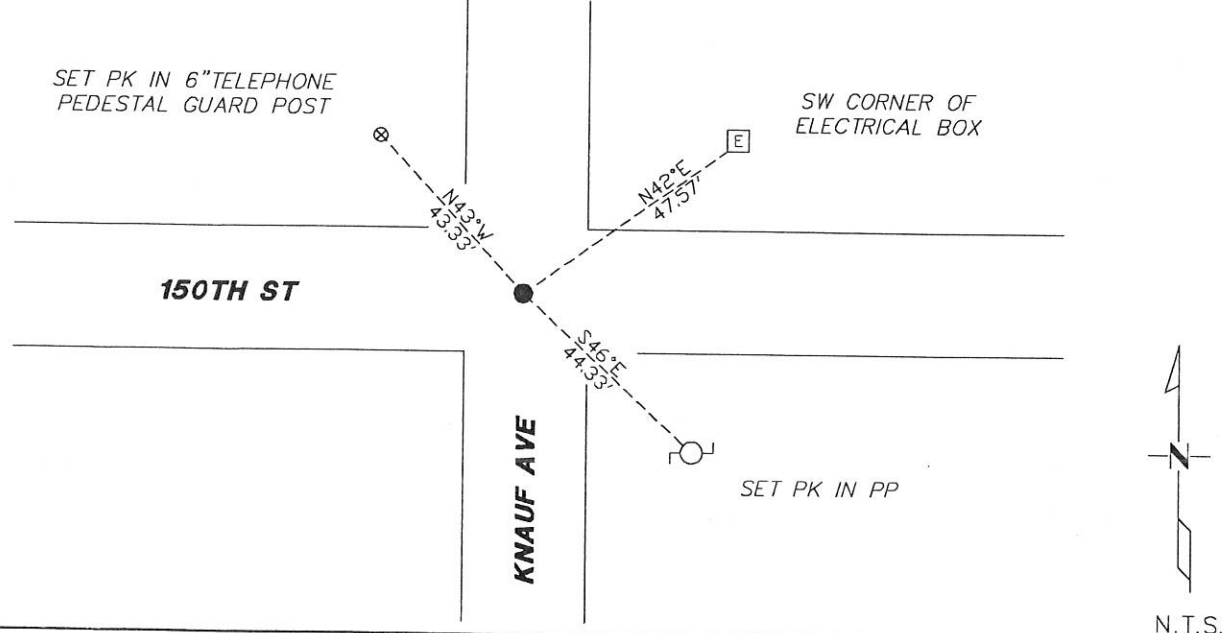

**Statement of Evidence:**

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Northeast Corner of Section 33, Township 104 North, Range 41 West, 5<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Nobles County, Minnesota.

1868-Deputy Surveyor Richard N. L. Jeorlt, set a post in mound with pits for the section corner.

1900-Surveyor's Record Book A-2, page 382, prepared by County Surveyor M.S. Smith shows a stone at the corner location. Distance to the S1/4 of Sec. 28 T.104 R.41 is shown to be 2690.7 ft.

2017-On November 9th, Westwood Professional Services found nothing. Holding N/S/E/W centerline intersection as the best available evidence of the corner position. N/S/E/W centerline intersection fits the 1900 survey distances. Set a 5/8" rebar capped 49563 and set 3 ties.

Analysis of the recovered data, field evidence and survey measurements, indicates that the monument found is the correct perpetuation of this corner. For additional information concerning this corner please contact Westwood Professional Services.
