2017-On November 10th, Westwood Professional Services found a No. 5 rebar on N/S centerline and online with occupation to the west, down 0.5 ft. Also found a No. 5 rebar +/-17 ft east of the one found at centerline, down 1.2 ft. Found 1 1980 Nobles County Highway Department tie which fits the easterly monument. Both monuments match stationing shown on C.S.A.H. No. 13 highway plans. Accepting the east No. 5 rebar as the correct position of the corner.
