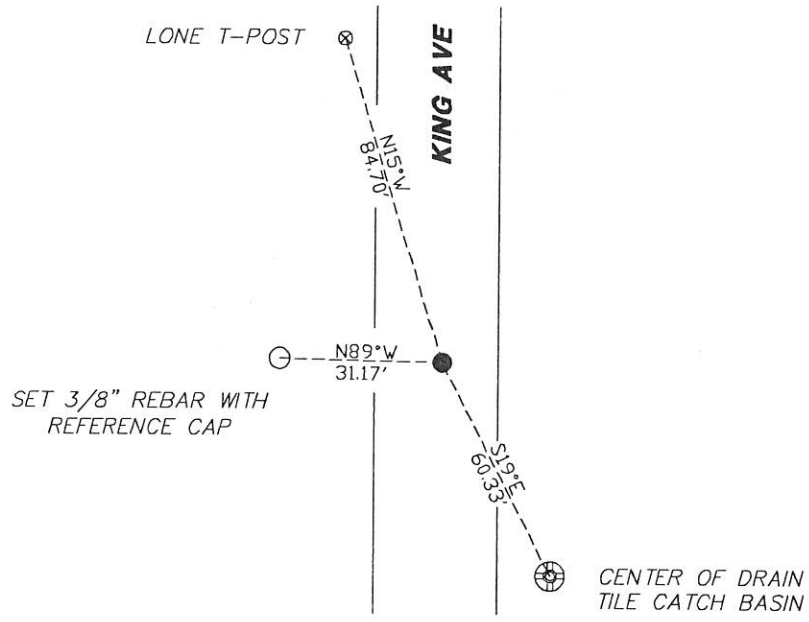

1868-Deputy Surveyor Richard N. L. Jeorlt, set a post in mound with pits for the section corner.

1900-Nobles County Highway Department "Corner Ties Book" calls for a stone at the corner location.

1900-Surveyor's Record Book A-2, page 382, prepared by County Surveyor M.S. Smith shows a stone at the corner location and states "found old Cottonwood".

2017-On November 9th, Westwood Professional Services searched at N/S centerline and online with berm running east; found nothing. Set a 5/8" rebar capped 49563 equidistant between the NE and SE corners of Section 29 T.104 R.41 and slid west to centerline. Position lands +/-3.5 ft. south of westerly berm extension. Ties were set as shown on the front of this certificate.
